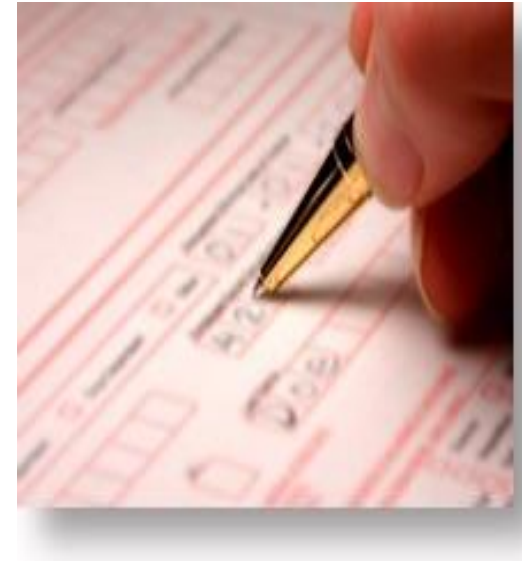

To qualify:

- Be a UK student and be liable for the UK home rate of tuition fees
- Apply for a place on a full-time, eligible Honours degree through UCAS by 15 January 2017.
- Be selected for the Unconditional Offer Scheme for High Achievers
- Meet or exceed the grades outlined in one sitting, during 2017.
